SESSION PLAN

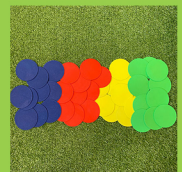
Things to remember:

- Children's names - make it your main priority to remember every child's name and mention everyone at least 3 times throughout a session.
- Phones away from the moment a parent and child arrive unless you are taking the register an assistant should never have their phone out.
- Interact as soon as a child enters the hall.

GAME

EQUIPMENT NEEDED

Small Cones
Footballs
Bazooka Goals
Pads



Setup:

Coaches need to divide the hall with small cones.
Goals set up as if it was two football pitches (goals opposite).
Coaches to provide each child with a bib. 4 teams of equal numbers.
Each team to have a coloured bib, to make it fun give them a team name that represents that colour (red bibs - Spain)

The Game:

Children sat in front of their team goal with a bucket of balls next to it.

Children run out and grab a ball from their team bucket (next to them) and dribble the balls to the oppositions goal and score.

Children will run back and grab another ball from their bucket.
Once all the balls are gone the game will reset.

There will be two matches happening at one time and the winners will face off against each other.

Once every team has played each other, combine the 4 teams into two, by placing two goals next to each other and one final large game can be played.
